Access to the library resources via **Google Scholar**

1. What are the resources available via Google Scholar?

Four databases available at the library which give access to academic journals are available via Google Scholar:

- Business Source Complete
- Emerald
- JSTOR
- ScienceDirect

3. Configure the access to the library's electronic resources via Google Scholar

Click on "Scholar Preferences"





Search Advanced Scholar Search

- From the heading "Library links", enter "HEC Paris"
- Click on "Find library"



Online access to library subscriptions is usually restricted to patrons of that library. You may need to login with your library password, use a campus computer, or configure your browser to use a library proxy. Please visit your library's website or ask a local librarian for assistance.

4. Search in Google and get access to the library's resources

- You are automatically redirected to the Google Scholar homepage
- Enter your search criteria
- Note: click on the link "Advanced Scholar search" to carry out a more precise search

- Click on the link

 access the homepage of the database. "Find title" links you to the list of issues in the journal in which the article has
 been published
